Letter from Pastor Brandon Hendricks



Greetings Gray Rock Church Family,

We are entering the most important season on the liturgical calendar!

This month, we enter the solemn and sacred season of Lent, a time of reflection, repentance, and preparation as we culminate with the celebration of Christ's death and resurrection during Holy Week. I encourage you to approach this season with an open heart, allowing God to refine and strengthen your spirit.

One of the most significant moments in our Lenten journey will be **Ash Wednesday**, which we will observe together on **Wednesday**, **March 5th**, **at 7 PM**. This service marks the beginning of Lent, calling us to repentance and renewal as we prepare our hearts for Easter. It is the kickoff for a series of special events we will be having, where we are looking to celebrate the fullness of this season in reverence and spiritual renewal.

I cannot stress how spiritually transforming these next few weeks leading up to Easter will be if you invest in your spiritual health by participating in these holy observances, which begins with our special Ash Wednesday service. This evening of reflection and encouragement reminds us that we are called to be a light in the darkness, offering love and support to those in need.

As we journey through this season, let us take to heart the words of 2 Corinthians 4:16: "Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day." True renewal is not just about outward change—it is a daily transformation of the heart as we draw closer to God. At the end of this season, we will be able to look back and see the miraculous things that God has done if we faithfully invest in the process of His transforming grace over these next few weeks.

May this March be a month of transformation, drawing us into deeper communion with God and one another. As we set our eyes on the hope of Easter, let us embrace this time of renewal with faith, fasting, and an open heart.


